The Precision Measurement Instruments(PMI) class is giving the students of Athol High School new opportunities.

With the help of Starret Tools, the PMI class is learning how to assemble and disassemble an engine, precisely use measurement instruments and the use of three-dimensional printing. The class is taught by Mr. Carl Seppala and is being offered for the first time since the automotive lab was shut down approximately 15 years ago.

Students receive certification for each of the six trays of tools they learn how to use correctly. The class is expected to understand basic safety guidelines related to the use of precision measurement instruments in shops and labs.

Students should be able to perform tool maintenance and explain how to read measurements accurately. The class will also be able to differ between calibration and field check, and determine when each should be done.
