## Learning Resource & Activities

Teachers are working to ensure your child has access to review and enrichment learning materials while schools are closed. Starting on Monday, March 23rd, you can access these materials one of three ways:

1. Each week, new learning activities and resources will be posted on the district website. Teachers will post new materials every Monday and Wednesday. Special education and title I teachers will post new resources Tuesdays and Thursdays.
