Notes About the Start of the School Year

- All students will participate in a remote learning orientation the week of Sept. 8-10.
- School will start remotely for all students on Sept. 14.
- The week of Sept. 28 students will be participating in an in-person orientation with their homeroom cohort for one full day. This is for students who have chosen in-person learning only. All students will still be working remotely when they are not in orientation.
- The week of Oct. 5 student learning will shift to the learning choice that they made with the front office (remote or in-person)
- This year attendance will be taken during all classes and learning will be moving forward. Students must participate in class meets and complete assignments as if they were in school, even if they are remote.
- When students are learning from home, parents should plan for a quiet place for their child to participate in remote learning. This will ensure the privacy of other members of their home as well as help the child focus on their learning.
- If you have multiple children working remotely, it will be important to provide them with their own space for Google Meets so that each child can fully engage in their lesson without distractions.
