Dear Parents/Guardians:

This letter is to clarify the schedule and procedure for the upcoming mid-year exams and finals.

Students will have an exam in every class. Year-long classes will give a mid-year exam that will count as 10% of the final grade. Semester long classes will give a final exam that will count as 20% of the final grade. These exams will begin on Wednesday, January 27, 2021 and continue through Friday, January 29, 2021.

On January 26, we will follow a regular Tuesday schedule with A & B period classes conducting review sessions and interested Juniors will take the PSAT. On January 27 and January 28, students will take two exams followed by two review sessions then may leave at 12:39pm. Lunch will be provided each day (see attached schedule). On January 30, students will take two exams and then may leave school at 10:25am.

Please note that because busses are shared with the middle school, the busses will run at their regular times. Students who do not have a ride home or wish to stay for extra support should schedule an extra help session with their teacher or report to the cafeteria where they may study for their next exam. If you would like us to make sure that your student remains in school on these days, please contact my office at (978) 249-2435.

The second semester will officially start on Monday, February 1, 2021. Our second quarter report cards will be distributed on Tuesday, February 2, 2021.
